



Saturday Triple Bypass Alternate Route Instructions

FOR THE SAFETY OF THE TOUR PARTICIPANTS AND OFFICIAL SUPPORT PERSONNEL, TEAM EVERGREEN REQUESTS THAT ALL PRIVATE SUPPORT VEHICLES READ AND ADHERE TO THESE INSTRUCTIONS. THANK YOU FOR YOUR COOPERATION.

Evergreen -> Idaho Springs:

NOTE: ROAD CLOSURE IN EFFECT on SATURDAY. Private Support Vehicles (PSV) will not be allowed on Highway 103. For the safety of tour participants and official support personnel, official support vehicles and local traffic only will be allowed past the check point. PSV's will be asked to meet riders in Idaho Springs.

- From Evergreen – take highway 74 back to I-70 westbound.
- Take I-70 (west) to Idaho Springs (this will only take about 30 minutes by car). Enjoy breakfast in Idaho Springs.
- Take the first Idaho Springs exit – Exit 238. Cyclists will be riding into Idaho Springs via Highway 103 which is Exit 240. Exit 240 will be closed and the bridge is under construction. Please wait for your rider in town.
- PLEASE BE RESPECTFUL OF LOCAL BUSINESSES AND TRAFFIC WHILE WAITING FOR RIDERS.

Idaho Springs -> Georgetown on Saturday:

NOTE: LOCATION FOR AID STATION #2 A ROAD CLOSURE WILL BE IN EFFECT ON ALVARADO ROAD – NO THROUGH TRAFFIC WILL BE ALLOWED. Private Support Vehicles will not be allowed on Alvarado Road. Please follow the instructions below to meet riders in Georgetown (parking will be provided in town, NOT at the aid station).

- Return to I-70 (westbound)
- Exit I-70 at Georgetown, proceed to the roundabout.
- Turn left at the roundabout. The parking area is located at the lake. The lot is located in the large open area adjacent to the Warming Hut. PLEASE PARK IN THIS LOT AND MEET RIDERS AT THIS LOCATION!
- DO NOT PARK ALONG THE SHOULDER OF THE FRONTAGE ROAD.

Georgetown -> Loveland:

**LOVELAND BASIN AID STATION IS GREAT LOCATION to meet up with your rider!!
Plenty of parking for private support vehicles at the Loveland Basin.**

- Exit 216 from I-70 at US 6/Loveland Pass
- Take a left off the east bound entrance ramp and head toward Loveland Basin
- Proceed to the Loveland Basin ski area – you will be directed into the rest stop to park.
- Enjoy live music provided by Epic Mountain Gear and cheer on the riders!
- NO PARKING ALONG US 6 – TICKETS WILL BE ISSUED!

**Loveland Pass will be closed to vehicle traffic from 10:00am-2:00pm.
CREW will NOT be able to meet riders at the top of Loveland Pass.**



Loveland -> Summit County:

NOTE: SWAN MOUNTAIN ROAD WILL BE CLOSED (WESTBOUND) TO ALL VEHICLES OTHER THAN OFFICIAL SUPPORT VEHICLES ON SATURDAY!

- Exit Loveland aid station and return to I-70 West. (You will not be able to follow riders over Loveland Pass – use the Eisenhower Tunnel)
- Proceed westbound on I-70 through the Eisenhower Tunnel.
- Remain on I-70 to the Frisco/Breckenridge exit 203 (Highway 9)
- Go south on Highway 9
- **Epic Mountain Gear - While riders are pedaling over Loveland Pass, head to Epic Mountain Gear in Frisco (Exit 203 off I-70 and a right at the first light, Lusher Court) and use the coupon in the rider packet for a discount at Epic Mountain Gear.**
- To get to the Summit Aid Station – proceed on Highway 9 (south) toward Breckenridge.
- Make a right turn at Swan Mountain Road into the Summit County High School parking lot. You will be directed to available parking by the Field House.

Summit County -> Vail Pass:

Riders will be on the bike path at this point. Please proceed to the Vail Pass Rest stop to meet your cyclist.

- Exit Summit County Aid Station stop by turning left onto Highway 9 and returning to Frisco
- Turn left at Main Street Frisco and proceed through town to I-70 (west bound)
- Stay on I-70 to the top of Vail Pass
- Exit 190 at the summit to the CDOT Rest Area.
- Please park in the designated area of the lot – use caution as riders will be riding through the parking lot to the rest area and access to the descent bike path.

Vail Pass -> Avon:

Riders will be on the Frontage Road in Vail but due to normal traffic within the city and multiple traffic roundabouts we ask that PSV avoid traveling along this road. Cyclists will be accessing the bike path in West Vail to Eagle-Vail. To avoid Avon traffic and proceed to Crew Parking

- Return to I-70 (westbound) from Vail Pass aid station
- **Option 1** - Remain on I-70 to the East Avon exit 168 to Post Road
- (Avoid the main Avon exit 167 because heavy traffic)
- Take a Left at the first roundabout to Post Road
- Right onto Highway 6 (west).
- Go straight through the roundabout at Avon Road/Beaver Creek roundabout.
- Elk Parking Lot will be on your left ¼ after the roundabout.
- **Option 2** – heading west on I-70, take exit 163 Edwards
- Left at the first roundabout onto Edwards Access Road
- Left at Highway 6 (east).
- Proceed for 3 miles on Highway 6 and the Elk Lot will be on your right.
- Shuttle buses will take you to the Avon Finish Area
- Elk Parking Lot is CREW parking and Rider Pick Up.
- NO PARKING IS AVAILABLE OR ALLOWED AT THE AVON FINISH LINE OR NOTTINGHAM PARK!
- Shuttle buses will running between Elk Lot and the Avon Rec Center/Finish Line

Avon -> Vail Pass:

Riders will be on the Frontage Road in Vail but due to normal traffic within the city and multiple traffic roundabouts we ask that PSV avoid traveling along this road. Cyclists will be accessing the bike path in West Vail.

- NO PARKING IS AVAILABLE AT AVON REC CENTER OR NOTTINGHAM PARK!
- Go through the roundabouts to the Beaver Creek and left on Avon Road to I-70 East
- Stay on I-70 to the top of Vail Pass
- Exit 190 at the summit to the CDOT Vail Pass Rest Area.
- Please park in the designated area of the lot – use caution as riders will be riding through the parking lot to the rest area and access to the descent bike path.

Vail Pass -> Summit County:

Riders will be on the bike path at this point. Please proceed to the Vail Pass Rest stop to meet your cyclist. NOTE: **NEW LOCATION FOR AID STATION ON SUNDAY – Snake River Saloon**

- Remain on I -70 eastbound and take Exit 205 and proceed onto Hwy 6
- Turn right on Highway 6
- Snake River Saloon will be prior to the Keystone Ski Area
- The riders will be going over Swan Mountain this year.
- Please stop and enjoy the hospitality of the Town of Dillon and Frisco. Also Silverthorne has Outlet Malls! (shopping, coffee, lunch etc)
- **Epic Mountain Gear - While riders are pedaling over Loveland Pass, head to Epic Mountain Gear in Frisco (Exit 203 off I-70 and a right at the first light, Lusher Court) and use the coupon in the rider packet for a discount at Epic Mountain Gear.**
- Please park in the designated areas

Keystone -> Loveland Basin:

**Loveland Pass will be closed to vehicle traffic from 10:00am -2:00pm.
PSV's will NOT be able to meet riders at the top of Loveland Pass.**

- Riders will be on Highway 6 and Loveland Pass.
- Take Highway 6 east from the Aid Station and return to I-70.
- Proceed east bound on I-70 through the Eisenhower Tunnel.
- Exit Loveland and at the bottom of the ramp turn right to the Loveland Basin parking lot.

Loveland Basin:

**LOVELAND BASIN AID STATION IS GREAT LOCATION to meet up with your rider!!
Plenty of parking for private support vehicles at the Loveland Basin.**

- Exit I-70 East at US 6/Loveland Pass
- Take a right off the ramp to Loveland Basin ski area
- You will be directed into the aid station to car parking



- Lots of music and cheering going on at Loveland
- NO PARKING ALONG US 6 – TICKETS WILL BE ISSUED!
- There is no parking at the top of Loveland Pass

Loveland -> Idaho Springs:

There are no road closures on Sunday.

- Return to I-70 (eastbound)
- Exit 240 on I-70 for Highway 103 (Squaw Pass)
- The Aid Station is on the right at the Clear Creek School District offices.
- NO CREW parking is available at the Idaho Springs Aid Station
- Good meeting place is the town of Idaho Springs, prior to the Aid Station on Colorado Blvd

Idaho Springs ->Evergreen:

NOTE: CREW will be asked to meet riders in Idaho Springs and the finish in Evergreen. The riders will be taking Highway 103 from Idaho Springs to Evergreen. There are spots to pull over and watch for riders. It would be faster for CREW to take I-70 to Evergreen.

- PLEASE BE RESPECTFUL OF LOCAL BUSINESSES AND TRAFFIC WHILE WAITING FOR RIDERS
- Take I-70 to Idaho Springs exit 240 and turn right. There is road construction going on the bridge at Exit 240.
- From Idaho Springs riders will take Highway 103 / Squaw Road / Juniper Pass.
- Highway 103 is the last climb before the finish.
- Echo Lake lodge is at the top.
- There is NO Parking at the Squaw Aid Station at Juniper Pass. Would suggest parking at one of the pull outs or maybe Echo Lake lodge
- The finish line is in Evergreen at Buchanan Park –
- Squaw Road crosses over Highway 74 (Evergreen Parkway)
- There is NO PARKING AT BUCHANAN PARK
- Parking is available at RTD Lot, Bergen Valley Elementary, Bergen Meadow Elementary, Evergreen Middle School, the upper lots at Bergen Village and Castle Court Office Buildings
- A shuttle bus can pick you up at the parking lots and take you to the finish line. It will be rotating from 2:00 pm to 8:00pm
